

PARISH POST

Dear sisters and brothers,

It's official - Los Angeles has four new auxiliary bishops! This joyous occasion lends itself to a quick review of the organization and governance of the Catholic Church. Why? because it can be confusing! So here it goes...

During his public ministry, Jesus Christ gathered his twelve apostles around himself. These were men he chose and his relationship with them was special. So much so, that during the last supper Jesus not only instituted the sacrament of the Eucharist but also the sacrament of holy orders. In this way Jesus shared his power with the twelve so that after his passion, death, and resurrection they would continue his mission of teaching, sanctifying, and governing God's people - the Church. They, in turn, did the same and before death appointed successors "and then ordered them that when they died other approved men would take their ministry" (Lumen Gentium, par. 20).

This means that starting with the apostles, Jesus continued to shepherd his Church by the power of the Holy Spirit through the ministry of bishops. As the church began to grow and expand it was divided up into geographic regions called provinces (i.e., the United States) which themselves were divided up into smaller regions called dioceses (i.e., Los Angeles). Dioceses, too, were subdivided into smaller regions called deaneries; and deaneries were subdivided into parishes (i.e., Visitation). Early on in the Church's history the bishops needed help to oversee the territories entrusted to them and they appointed collaborators to assist them (i.e., priests and deacons). Hence, bishops oversee dioceses and priests oversee parishes.


Fast forward to more recent church history: in some cases, when dioceses are particularly large, a bishop will have auxiliary-bishops assist him. Because the territory of the Los Angeles Archdiocese is so large (comprising LA, Ventura, and Santa Barbara counties) we have five auxiliary bishops assisting our Archbishop. Each of the five "helper bishops" oversees one of the five pastoral regions in the Archdiocese. Up until July 18th four of those five regions had been without an auxiliary bishop (for various reasons). Now, Pope Francis (Bishop of Rome and Vicar of Christ) has appointed four new auxiliary bishops for Los Angeles. Their names are: Msgr. Alber Buhhuth, Fr. Matthew Elshoff OFM Cap., Fr. Brian Nunes, and Fr. Slawomir Szkredka. We have yet to see the regions to which they'll be assigned and their ordination day is September 26th. Let's be sure to keep them in our prayers!


