

PARISH POST

Dear sisters and brothers,

Next Sunday, June 11th, is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ which is a special day to celebrate what Jesus tells us in the Bible: "*For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him*" (John 6:55). Friends, we are never alone because God seeks us out! Jesus comes to us in the Eucharist.

For this reason, the parish phase of the 3-year National Eucharistic Revival begins on this day. This means that for a year beginning on June 11th every parish is to conscientiously "foster Eucharistic devotion by strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit." In this way, we'll work to revive our love for Jesus in the Eucharist and go out to share this love with others (US Bishops).

In Los Angeles, Archbishop José Gomez has asked each parish to kick-off this year of parish revival with a Eucharistic Procession on June 11th. Processions remind us that we are pilgrims on a journey, and we follow Jesus on our way to heaven. "In a Eucharistic Procession, we publicly proclaim this truth, following the Lord physically even as we pledge anew to do so spiritually. We also give public witness to our acceptance of the Lord's words: 'The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world' (Jn 6:51). As such, public processions serve as tools of evangelization within our neighborhoods" (*Simply Catholic*).

Therefore, I'd like to invite all of you to join us on Sunday, June 11th, for the 11am Mass and a Eucharistic Procession around the block (Emerson - Liberator - W 88th). The procession will begin after the 11am Mass and conclude with benediction in the church. Afterward, we will enjoy hospitality in the O'Grady Center/Mary's Courtyard. I look forward to seeing you there as we start off strong the Eucharistic Revival at Visitation.




Our community is partnering with every parish, mission, and Catholic center in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles to strengthen parishes, families, and communities.


