Dear brothers and sisters,

Once again, it brings me great joy to announce that Archbishop Gomez has appointed me for another one-year term as Administrator of Visitation Parish! I am looking forward to another blessed year with all of you and I know that the Lord has many special graces in store for us. I realize, however, that the news of a “one-year term as Administrator” is a bit confusing for some of you so I’d like to take this opportunity to explain how the process of priestly assignments works (at least here in Los Angeles).

One’s journey to the priesthood concludes with the completion of the requirements for a Master of Divinity degree, graduation from the seminary, and ordination to the priesthood. The newly ordained priest then receives an assignment from the bishop of his diocese. In most cases, a priest's first assignment is to serve as a “parochial vicar” at a parish for 3-4 years. A parochial vicar is like a helper priest to the pastor of a parish. One’s time as a parochial vicar is important for learning from the good example of the pastor and gaining a familiarity with priestly life and ministry. When it is determined that a priest is possibly ready to become a pastor, the bishop will assign him to a parish as an “administrator”. To be an administrator of a parish is similar to being a pastor of a parish in the sense that an administrator is the priest “in charge” of the spiritual care of his flock. The main difference, however, is that an administrator serves a one-year term whereas a pastor serves a six-year term. And so before locking a recently ordained priest in as pastor for six years, many bishops find it helpful to assign priests who have never been pastors before for a couple of one-year terms as administrator. This allows both the priest and the diocese to discern if the priest is ready to become a pastor. Once mutual discernment has taken place and a priest is ready, the bishop will assign him as pastor of a parish for a six-year term.

In my case, I was ordained a priest in 2018 and spent one term, four years, at St. Anthony Parish in San Gabriel, CA. The conclusion of this assignment coincided with Fr. Jim Forsen's retirement and it was decided that I would come to Visitation as an administrator so as to allow for continued discernment around my readiness to become a pastor. After receiving my request to stay at Visitation and interviewing Visitation staff and parishioners, Archbishop Gomez decided to assign me for another one-year term as administrator at Visitation. Praise God!

I hope this helps explain the process a bit and if you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask. All I can say is that the Archbishop’s trust and your kind affirmation have been incredible blessings for me and I am truly grateful! May the Lord who has brought us together bring to fulfillment his most holy will this next year and always.

DID YOU KNOW? RECOGNIZE SIGNS OF GROOMING BEHAVIOR

Many adult predators “groom” their victims, creating an emotional and psychological connection with a child to lay the groundwork for future sexual abuse. Some basic signs of child grooming can include taking an undue interest in someone else’s child, or calling a child a “special friend.” Groomers may give money or gifts for no reason, or invite a potential victim on isolated day trips or outings without the child’s parents. 
