Carbon monoxide is an odorless, colorless gas that is often undetected. More than 400 people in the U.S. die every year from unintentional carbon monoxide poisoning, and thousands more are hospitalized. When gas builds up in enclosed spaces, people or animals who breathe it in can be poisoned. Consider installing a battery-operated carbon monoxide detector, and have your furnace, water heater, and other gas or coal-burning appliances serviced regularly, along with your chimney. PASTOR POST**Continue to Renew**

Wouldn't it be wonderful to have no money worries? To be financially set for life? But, with the rare exception of the 1%-ers, who's kidding who? We all have to struggle to make ends meet. So with all the concerns each of us has over money, the need to pay bills, cover the mortgage, buy groceries and gas and allowances for the kids and hopefully have enough leftover for vacation, no one comes to church on Sunday and listen to a priest talking about money. And believe me, just about every priest I know hates talking about money from the pulpit. But just as a family has to deal with money issues in order to make ends meet, so to does the church. Last week at all the masses, we distributed the "State of the Parish" message, showing the financial as well as the spiritual health of Visitation. If you missed it, please go online and see it at our website, or pick up a brochure at the rectory or the doors of the church. Through the careful managing of expenses, and the overwhelming generosity of our parishioners, we have weathered the Covid lockdown and it's aftermath well. Thanks be to God and to all of you and to the excellent staff of our parish. We also talked about the success of Renew Visitation and how it has so successfully renovated both the structure as well as the spirit of this community. We all did great work, and there is still great work that needs to be done. The O'Sullivan Hall is in need of renovations in the kitchen and ventilation as well as bringing the restrooms up to code. It needs air conditioning, as does the junior high classrooms. The building needs new flooring, restrooms, painting. Our storage bins for the church and the school need a facelift. Most importantly, we want to create an endowment fund for our parish which can ensure it's future financial security. This is why we are beginning a new financial campaign for this coming year:

Continue to Renew. I have hired a part time Director of Development, Courtney O'Donoghue, who will assist me and our community in the endeavor to raise another million dollars. Now let me ask you. Doesn't that seem impossible? Well, didn't it seem impossible to raise \$3.5 million over the last three years? But we did that and more. As was also said on Sunday, we have kicked off the campaign, already raising \$100,000. So I am confident in this coming year, that we will be able to achieve our goal. My hope is that we can place Visitation on a secure financial ground. Not that we won't have money worries in the future, or that emergencies won't come up, but that, as Jesus once said in a parable, our house is built on solid rock so that future storms might not sweep it away.


