Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of one of the great penitential seasons of our Church year: Lent. For many, “penance” is a negative word that reflects a dark and dreary spirituality. That’s why I think it is wonderful that Ash Wednesday (the beginning of Lent) falls on Valentine’s Day this year because they both point to the same reality: loving relationships.

The connection between Valentine’s Day and loving relationships is clear enough. Husbands and wives; boyfriends and girlfriends go to great lengths - sacrifice - to express their love for each other. From ice-skating rinks and bike rides to mountaintops and ocean breezes - couples brave all sorts of challenges to express and rekindle their love. During Lent we do something very similar. As a way of preparing for Easter, we embrace self-denial which we traditionally express through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These are not weird sadistic practices, but gems of Catholic spirituality (also found in many other religious traditions btw) that effectively draw our hearts back to the Lover of all lovers - God. You see, we can so easily become self-centered. We can easily allow our priorities to get out of whack. Simply, we so easily forget about God. Lent, with its penitential practices, is about letting go of disordered attachments, returning home, and allowing God’s love to penetrate our hearts anew. Lent is all about Love.



So whatever you decide to “give up” or “take on” for Lent, I ask that you do it for the right reasons. Although we should challenge ourselves, this isn’t about winning a gold medal in the spiritual Olympics. It’s about a loving encounter with God as we prepare to celebrate the greatest event in history at Easter: the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! So this Lent, whatever you do, do it for LOVE!

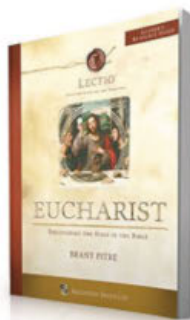
Celebrate the Eucharistic Revival at Visitation
