

PARISH POST March 31, 2024

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Happy Easter! Today we rejoice because the Lord is truly risen - alleluia! I pray that this Easter season is a special time of grace for you and your loved ones.

In my pastoral work I've become aware that many people are familiar with Jesus' passion, death, and resurrection but they are not as familiar with what happened next. That is, they aren't too familiar with what we celebrate during the Easter Season as a whole. For example, did you know that Jesus - the glorified risen Lord - remained on earth for 40 days after his resurrection from the dead? If that's true then it begs the question, "What was he doing?" We don't have all the details but the Bible makes it clear that he first made some important visits to Mary Magdalene (John 20), the disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24), and the apostles in the upper room (John 20). After appearing several times to his disciples, the Bible says that he also appeared to more than 500 people (1 Cor 15:6). Although I have no scriptural evidence, my personal opinion is that Jesus must have first made a special visit to the Blessed Virgin Mary, his mother... it just makes sense!:)

After 40 days, Jesus then commissioned his apostles to baptize and bring the Good News of the Gospel to the whole world and then he ascended to heaven (Mark 16:14-19, Acts 1:1-11). By ascension we mean that he was taken up to heaven body and soul by his own power. Ten days after his ascension (50 days after his resurrection) Jesus sent his Holy Spirit upon the Apostles (and Mary!) gathered in the upper room (Acts 2). This is what we celebrate on Pentecost Sunday which concludes the Easter Season (pentecost means '50 days').

My point is that the Easter Season begins with the resurrection but continues for 50 days as we commemorate the important work Jesus continued to do among his disciples. I pray that all of us will allow the risen Lord's life and love to continue 'working' on us for the entire Easter Season and always. God bless and Happy Easter!

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Question: What is spiritual communion, and do you need to be in a state of grace to receive it?

Answer: The practice of making a "spiritual communion" dates back several centuries and St. Thomas Aquinas described it as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Holy Sacrament and a loving embrace as though we had already received Him." Traditionally, a prayer of spiritual communion has been used by those who are unable to receive sacramental communion because of health, inability to attend Mass, or who cannot receive communion because of grave sin. This practice has been encouraged by many saints and spiritual writers and most recently Pope Francis encouraged the practice when the realities of the COVID-19 pandemic prevented so many Catholics from taking part in the Mass or receiving sacramental communion.

Although the graces offered in spiritual communion are not the same as those offered in the sacramental communion of the Mass, this practice is still a powerful opportunity to express our desire for union with the Lord and to be united with Christ and the Church, even in an imperfect way.

ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love you above all things, and desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you. / Amen.


Sharing the Gospel




