Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Holy Week is just that; holy. It is holy-time set apart to commemorate the love of God who gave His only begotten Son that we might have eternal life (Jn 3:16). During these holiest of days we accompany Jesus Christ as he accomplishes the great work of our salvation.

On Palm Sunday, we wave our palm branches and proclaim Christ victorious with the words "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest"! 




